Stepping Stones Crisis Society's Second Stage Housing Program is intended to assist women and their dependent children who are fleeing intimate partner violence with getting re-established in the community by providing ongoing support and affordable housing. The housing units consist of 2 and 3 bedroom secure, fully furnished apartments within the City of Cold Lake. These units are based on a 1-3 month term for up to 2 years. During the family's stay in these units, they will be supported by a Family Support Worker, a Child and Family Counsellor, Child Support, and an Outreach Team, with programming based on each individual woman's needs. This will help women become comfortable living independently and establish their own rental history to be able to secure their own housing in the future.
